







This is my 3rd year in joining Marian at Seams to be Sew with her annual row along.

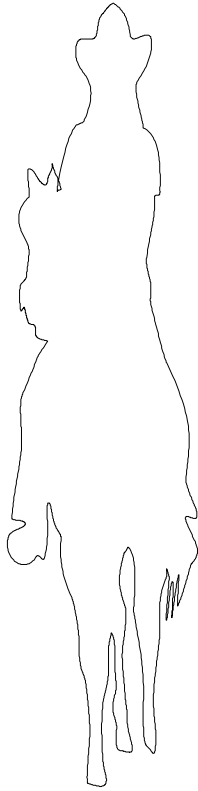
Assembly Instructions:

Assemble all 3 blocks refereing to the color diagaragms for each block.

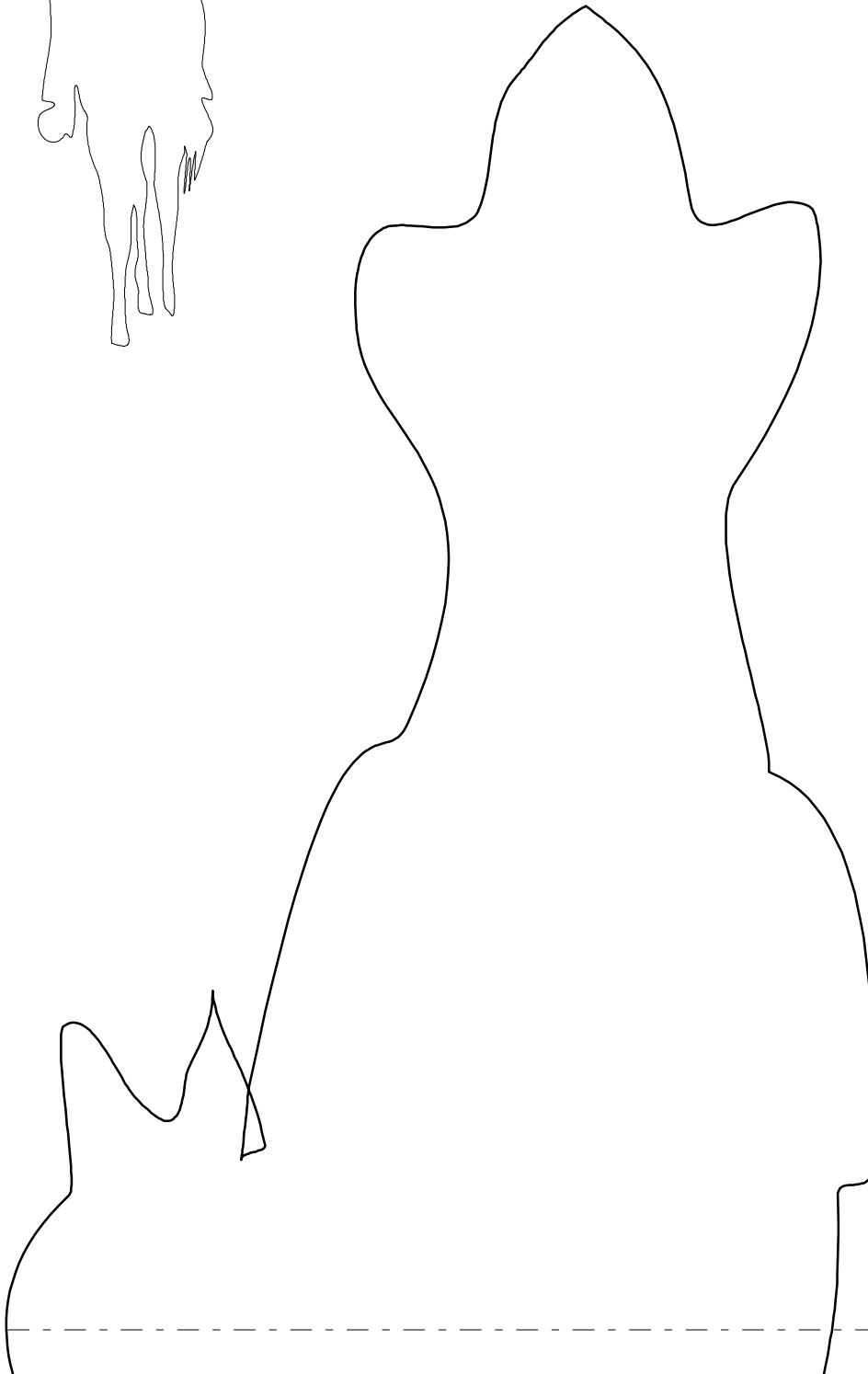
Sew the blocks , 2, and 3, in a vertical row.
